

2 the APPROACH


Introduce students to five foundational traits—Respect, Responsibility, Caring, Fairness, and Honesty (RRCFH)—as the pillars of strong character. Encourage each child to embody these qualities in their interactions and to expect the same from others, creating a shared culture of accountability and mutual respect.

3 the PROCESS

Engage students through colorful stories, videos, interactive photo cards, plush puppets, and hands-on activities that bring each trait to life. By exploring how these traits look, sound, and feel, students deepen their understanding and social awareness. Each lesson blends essential values with practical social skills, making character education both joyful and impactful.

EACH BOOK IS — Large, durable, and easy to see. Both depict 15 situations in two ways.

Those 15 situations teach the 5 Traits in 3 locations, Class, Recess, and Home. Scene 1 presents a negative example and students are asked about what they see, what sounds they imagine, how

they think these people feel, and lastly, to describe what they think the positive example will be like.

In Scene 2 students see a positive example and are asked if their guess was correct, the sounds they imagine, and how the people feel now.







